The entire executive committee has been bubbling with activities since the allotment of the subcommittee responsibilities to each of the executive committee members. It will be my honest duty to introduce each one of them with their respective responsibilities.

Prof. Asim Kumar Ghosh: PG Education Subcommittee: Regular PG Education programs is being held on a regular basis. The first meet was on Retina was held at RIO on 16th December. 110 students and 12 faculties attended the program. The second meet has been scheduled on 17th February 2023, and the topic will be on Paediatric Ophthalmology. The preparations are under full swing.

children of the leprosy affected families in the leprosy colony at Namo, Sagarbhanga, Durgapur. We checked up 97 leprosy patients and 105 school children in this comprehensive eye check-up program.

Dr. Dipa Saha: Observership Subcommittee: This is yet another venture OSWB will be dealing into for the very first time in its history. This will further encompass Mentor-Mentee programs to cater at the individual level of observership.

Dr. Maneesh Singh: Journal Club Subcommittee: This will be yet another first of its kind venture in our Society. This subcommittee will organise the regular feedback of recent advances from the journals to the clinic every month in different subspecialities.
