Warm greetings from the LOC of AIOC 2024.

A mere thank you falls short in expressing our heartfelt gratitude to each member of OSWB who supported us in organizing the mega event - 82<sup>nd</sup> All India Ophthalmological Conference of AIOS at Biswa Bangla Convention Centre, Newtown, Kolkata from 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. Today all 6500 plus delegates who attended and all our AIOS office bearers have voiced, both in spoken and written words, that this has been the best conference in recent memory. The trade delegates from nearly 200 companies have unanimously described the facilities as the best they have had. The international Faculty numbering more than 100 have also enjoyed the conference very much. It is indeed very gratifying to get this sort of positive feedback after months of hard work.

To us the enjoyment of having organized this Conference successfully, increases manifold when we learn that our own members of OSWB have found this journey to AIOC 2024 very satisfying. That is the reward for our passion, when many of you came forward to share the experiences that you have had with your friends and colleagues who attended from other parts of India. Right from the early planning stage to the final execution, we have tried to involve as many as possible and you have also responded kindly. The extended LOC consisted of more than 200 of our members and most of you at some stage or other have corresponded and participated in the preparations of this conference. We also thank profusely the leadership of EIZOC and all the Eastern states for their whole-hearted support and cooperation for coming together in making LOC of the East and for successfully organizing this 'Conference by the East'.

Do consider the vastness of the conference – 20 scientific halls plus 1,50,000 sq feet of space occupied by trade and other activities; along with the hugely popular lavish Food Court of about 50,000 sq feet; a dedicated Multilevel-car-parking facility at our disposal for as many as 1500 vehicles and of course the Gala dinner venue comprising of a vast AC Hangar for performance and the indoor Banquet with its adjoining open lawns- it was like a real destination evening. Add to this, the more than 500 sessions with 21 international Societies collaborating; 200 plus posters and videos; 7 sub-specialty days introduced first time and the very successful Glaucoma Walk & Cyclothon Rally consisting of over 500 participants, that we had on 15th March'24 morning to celebrate the International Glaucoma Week. Even the West Bengal Medical Council sanctioned 24 CME Credit Hours to AIOC 2024, which is unprecedented in history of AIOS. There were also the inaugural AIOC Utsav cultural program; the popular River Cruise on Ganges; an awesome Heritage Walk through the streets of Kolkata; and then the usual meetings of AIOS. We also engaged with all the delegates through email, SMS and an app created for the purpose for providing support to make their visit hassle-free. We had a QR code and websitebased Grievance Redressal system for the attendees. We maintained a 24X7 Toll-free phone number 1800-202-2024 for answering any queries from the delegates for more than 1 month before the conference. For receiving the delegate, we maintained a round-the-clock Welcome-kiosk inside the Kolkata Airport beside Belt No. 5 and all the belts carried the Welcome Message from AIOC 2024 on LED screens playing in loop all through the week. There was also a Beyond Ophthal Studio, Music Lounge and many more activities for the delegates. We had a Prayer Room facility with Iftaar arrangements for those of our delegates who were on Ramadan fasting. There was round the clock tea-coffee arrangements in the venue with a shop facility for buying refreshments if anybody wanted. We ordered packet lunch box for those delegates who preferred having the same. Towards realizing our endeavour to reduce the carbon footprint of such a large meeting, we had decided to implement a few eco-friendly measures. We provided sustainable and recyclable jute fibre kit bags; we gave each delegate a reusable branded stainless steel water bottle to be refilled from water cooler stations throughout the venue in order to minimize the use of plastic water bottles; we had recyclable earthen cups used to serve tea from the counters; we encouraged use of LED and minimized diesel generator set usage; we also had e-Brochure and e-Souvenir. There was indeed a lot going on.
